Center-Based ABA Services

ABA THERAPY: ABA services are overseen by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). 25 hours per week is typically recommended. Hourly, half-day, and full-day programs are available.

FUNCTIONAL BEHAVIOR ASSESSMENT (FBA): During the FBA process, a BCBA defines target behaviors, interviews caregivers, interacts with the child, observes and collects data in multiple environments. Upon conclusion, a unique Behavior Intervention Plan is recommended .

GROUP / SOCIAL SKILLS TRAINING: Role play and games help the children learn essential skills in a fun way. Goals are developed based on needs and data is collected, tracked, and analyzed to show progress and mastery of skills.



Home-Based ABA Services

ABA THERAPY:

For families who are not local to our center. TUT also offers ABA therapy in your home. Once again, our services are overseen by a BCBA. 25 hours per week is typically recommended. Hourly, half-day, and full-day programs are available.



FUNCTIONAL BEHAVIOR ASSESSMENT (FBA):

TUT will also travel to your home to conduct an FBA. Upon conclusion, a unique Behavior Intervention Plan is recommended.

HOME-BASED ABA DEVELOPMENT, TRAINING, AND MONITORING: Our consultation

services are designed to help families set up their own intervention programs, modeled after our program. During a 2-3 day initial consultation, the behavior consultant will model teaching procedures then help you practice these procedures. Follow-up consultations are conducted once every 4-6 weeks.



School-Based ABA Services

SCHOOL SHADOW THERAPY: Your child receives direct support at school. Shadow therapists are a necessary tool when transitioning a child with ASD to a regular education setting.

OBSERVATIONS: Our BCBA will observe your child and complete a report, including any relevant recommendations or observations. This is a unique opportunity for a "third-party" neutral look at the educational setting.

IEP SUPPORT AND CONSULTATION: Our BCBA will review your child's IEP draft and offer objective advice and general feedback to ensure that the child's IEP contains the most effective educational and behavioral strategies for the student. This is ideal for the parent seeking a second opinion on their child's IEP.



Community-Based ABA Services

LEARNING IN FUNCTIONAL ENVIRONMENTS

LIFE: The program focuses on social and living skills within real life environments. Sessions occur in the community in various settings with the purpose of building specific skills.

SUMMER THERAPY PROGRAM: During our summer therapy program, we focus on social-communication, learning and daily living skills and reduce problematic behavior. Like our center-based programs, our summer therapy program operates on a one-to-one ratio, but can also include small- and large-group settings.



CAMP INCLUSION PROGRAM

The Camp Inclusion program is designed to enable children to attend a mainstream camp with the support of a 1:1 therapeutic counselor, with the outcome being improvement and generalization of targeted treatment goals. Therapy will take place at your choice of camp—providing approval.
