

What Makes TUT Stand Apart?

Understanding the characteristics and components of a strong ABA Provider is critical to the outcome of a child diagnosed with autism.

- Similar to the medical field, TUT provides key Clinical Specialists in areas of assessment, programming, parent training, and therapist best practices.
- TUT provides Case Managers (not BCBAs) to provide support in areas of coordination of logistics, insurance, management of clinical staff, etc. This allows the BCBA to focus more on the child's direct care and treatment plan.
- TUT provides ABA best practices to ensure adherence to BACB Guidelines based on 45 years of research.
- Assurance of 1:1 support and 20% BCBA oversight (6-8 hours per week). All therapy is in person.
- TUT ensures a very low BCBA to student ratio (4-5 children compared to the norm of 6-15).
- We have a dedicated Professional Development team who identify core skills needed in our therapists and BCBAs.
- Most agencies focus on two or three of the components that make up an ABA program. TUT takes into consideration all nine components to ensure our ABA programs and ABA delivery are as strong and comprehensive as possible.
- TUT provides milestone achievement graphs that show your child's progress against typical peers.
 Our mission is to close that gap.
- TUT provides a strong transition process (Bridges) that places your child in a learning environment that mirrors a pre-k and kindergarten classroom.
